Today – Marine layer low clouds and fog should burn-off by 8-9am. High clouds will be passing overhead making for partly cloudy skies for the rest of the day. Can't rule out the marine layer moving back on-shore during the afternoon as well. Otherwise, temperatures will be mild with highs reaching the low to mid 60s. Calm wind this morning will shift out of the west 5-10 mph by midday/early afternoon.

Extended forecast – The marine layer will deepen Saturday night into Sunday morning making low clouds and fog more widespread for the morning hours ahead of a trough of low pressure that will move inland during the day. The fog should burn-off allowing for more sunshine for the afternoon. Temperatures will be cooler with highs reaching the upper 50s to low 60s in the afternoon. Patchy fog will be possible again Monday morning before off-shore flow strengthens over the region providing sunny skies and warmer temperatures into early next week.
