Things to Know

- Lanto Griffin holds his first career 54-hole lead/co-lead and has never finished in the top 10 on the PGA TOUR
- All four winners during the 2019-20 season have held at least a share of the lead after 54 holes
- Beau Hossler looks to become the first player since 2008 to win after losing that event in a playoff the last time it was played

Third-Round Lead Notes

- Third-round leaders/co-leaders to win the Houston Open since move to Golf Club of Houston (Tournament Course) in 2006 (most recent: Ian Poulter/2018)
- Third-round leaders/co-leaders to win in 2019-20 (all four winners held at least a share of the lead after 54 holes)

Lanto Griffin (1st/-11)

- First career 54-hole lead/co-lead; best previous 54-hole position: T12/2018 Farmers Insurance Open (finished T12)
- Ties career-best back-nine score with a 31 (sixth instance; first since R2/2019 Shriners Hospitals for Children Open)
- Only player to finish in the top 20 at all four events during the 2019-20 season (13th/A Military Tribute at The Greenbrier, T11/Sanderson Farms Championship, T17/Safeway Open, T18/Shriners Hospitals for Children Open)
- Entered the week leading the TOUR in Total Birdies (70) and leads the field in that category (19)
- Making second start at the Houston Open (first: MC/2018)
- No top-10s on the PGA TOUR; last player to earn first career top-10 with a victory: Dylan Frittelli/2019 John Deere Classic
- Shot a second-round 74; last player to win with at least one round of 74 or higher: Brooks Koepka/2019 PGA Championship

Mark Hubbard (2nd/-10)

- Previous best 54-hole position: T10/2015 Puerto Rico Open (finished T27)
- Only player in the field with three scores in the 60s
- Earned first career top-10 at the 2019 A Military Tribute at The Greenbrier (T10)
- Making fourth start at the Houston Open (MC/2015, T19/2016, MC/2017)

Beau Hossler (T3/-9)

- Leads the field in Strokes Gained: Putting (6.434)
- Lost in a playoff at the 2018 Houston Open; the last player to lose in a playoff and win the event the next time it was played was Ryuji Imada at the 2008 AT&T Classic
- Making fourth start of the 2019-20 season; best result: T29/Shriners Hospitals for Children Open
- Missed the FedExCup Playoffs in 2018-19 (No. 145) and earned his 2019-20 PGA TOUR card through the Korn Ferry Tour Finals (finished 17th in the final priority ranking)

Brandon Wu (T6/-8)

- As an amateur in 2019, finished T35/U.S. Open and MC/The Open Championship; first amateur since 1967 to qualify for both U.S. Open and The Open Championship in the same calendar year
- Making his professional debut on the PGA TOUR
- Represented the United States at the 2019 Walker Cup
- Member of Stanford's 2019 NCAA Championship team

Miscellaneous Notes

- The last time two players or fewer were 10-under or better after 54 holes was the 2019 U.S. Open (Gary Woodland/-11, Justin Rose/-10)
- Cameron Tringale (T3) birdied his last four holes to get to 9-under; finished in the top five twice in 2018-19 (T5/Zurich Classic of New Orleans, T5/Rocket Mortgage Classic)
- 36-hole leader **Peter Malnati** (T3) shot a third-round 73; in search of second career victory (first: 2015 Sanderson Farms Championship) and first top-10 since the 2019 Zurich Classic of New Orleans (T9)
