FedExCup Standings & Wyndham Rewards Top 10 Notes

- 8** Last season, eight of the final top 10 in the Wyndham Rewards Top 10 were inside the top 10 of the standings with six weeks remaining in the Regular Season.
- 2** Webb Simpson (1st) and Rory McIlroy (5th) are the only two players from last season's Final Wyndham Rewards Top 10 who are currently inside the top 10 with six weeks left in regular season
- >50th** Since 2009, only two players have been outside the top 50 of the FedExCup standings with six weeks to go and went onto finish the Regular season inside the top 10
Jordan Spieth (2013, 56th to 8th) *Henrik Stenson (2013, 53rd to 9th)*
- 1** In the last 11 PGA TOUR seasons, Rory McIlroy is the only player to finish first in the Final Regular Season standings after being outside the top-two of the FedExCup standings with six weeks to go.
- 26** Since 2009, with six weeks left 26 players started outside the top-10 and played their way into the final top 10 of the regular season standings (*most in a season: 4 (2010)*)
- 31** Players have ranked inside the top 125 of the FedExCup in all 24 weeks this season
- 16** Players have ranked inside the top 70 of the FedExCup in all 24 weeks this season
- 6** Players have ranked inside the top 30 of the FedExCup every week this season
- 23** Sebastian Munoz has spent the most weeks inside the top 10 of the standings of any player this season. Munoz fell to 11th in the standings after missing the cut at last week's Rocket Mortgage Classic, marking the first time this season he has ranked outside the top 10 of the standings.
- +67** Matthew Wolff moved up 67 positions in the FedExCup standings by virtue of his runner up finish. Wolff moved from 111th to 44th, marking his highest career rank in the FedExCup standings.
- 4** Last season, four players qualified for the FedExCup Playoffs finishing the regular season inside the top-125 of the FedExCup after being 150th or worse in the standings with six weeks left. The four players last season is the most to qualify for the FedExCup standings after being 150th or worse in the standings with six weeks to go over the last 11 PGA TOUR seasons

Currently ranked 155th in the FedExCup standings Brooks Koepka is seeking to for the FedExCup Playoffs for the sixth consecutive season. Last season, four players 150th or worse in FedExCup standings with six weeks left and qualified for the FedExCup Playoffs.

Fast Facts on Brooks Koepka:

- 40th** Recorded his 40th career top-10 finish on TOUR in his most recent start (RBC Heritage, 7th)
- 30.30%** Has the fourth-highest top-10 percentage of players currently 30 years old and younger on TOUR. Koepka has recorded a top 10 in 30.30% of his starts (40 of 132).
- 31.75%** Has the third best Bounce Back percentage of any player this season (31.75%)
- +17.07** Brooks Koepka has improved on the greens in his last eight rounds since the return to golf compared to his first 12 measured rounds this season. Koepka has improved by +17.07 total strokes on the greens in the last eight rounds and has made **19%** of his putts from outside 10 feet (15 of 80) compared to just **12%** (15 of 124) before the season was suspended.

In the last 11 PGA TOUR season, Jordan Spieth is one of only two players who have been outside the top 50 with six weeks remaining and finish the Regular season inside the Wyndham Rewards Top 10 (accomplishing this feat in 2013).

Posted all four rounds in the 60s in most recent start (*2020 Travelers Championship*), marks the first time since the 2018 Sony Open in Hawaii where Jordan Spieth has posted all four rounds in an event below 70.

Viktor Hovland is one of three players who have finished inside the top-25 in each of the four events since the PGA TOUR season resumed (*Bryson DeChambeau & Lucas Glover*).
