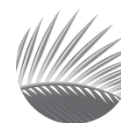




Today – A few pop-up showers and thunderstorms will be possible this morning as instability builds under mostly clear skies. A cold front approaching from the northwest is likely to push an area of thunderstorms through the region this afternoon. The highest likelihood for rain and thunderstorms is forecast from 2-4pm. Winds are expected to increase out of the north-northwest after 2pm this afternoon, breeziest along the exposed ocean holes. The temperature will reach a high in the low 80s.

Rainfall through 6pm: 0.50-1.00", locally higher possible in heavy showers or thunderstorms.
