Today – Moisture levels will slowly increase ahead of an approaching cold front, with showers forecast to develop after 2pm. These slow-moving showers will first develop over El Yunque National Forest and will erratically drift off the higher terrain due to a variable wind pattern. Heavy downpours are possible within these showers. The temperature will reach a high near 84F.

Tomorrow – Showers will be likely Monday morning through the early afternoon before becoming progressively more scattered later in the day as a cold front slowly drifts over Puerto Rico. Moderate to heavy rainfall intensities are expected within these showers on Monday. Gusty east-northeasterly winds are forecast throughout the day. The temperature will reach a high near 81F. **Rainfall: 0.50" – 1.00", with locally higher amounts possible.**
