Today – Passing showers are a possibility through mid-morning, with largely dry conditions taking over for from late morning through the early afternoon. After 3-4pm expect showers developing over the Virgin Islands to pass through at times, though a majority of the late afternoon will be dry as well. Easterly winds may reach speeds up to 25 mph this afternoon. The temperature is forecast to reach a high near 82F.
