Today – A stalled frontal boundary is across South-Central Florida and will be the focus for scattered showers and isolated thunderstorms developing this afternoon. These showers could produce heavy rainfall in a short period of time. Otherwise, mostly cloudy skies and breezy conditions can be expected this morning with temperatures warming through the 70s into the low 80s by midday.

Extended forecast – Partly to mostly cloudy skies can be expected on Friday with only a slight chance for a shower. Another weak cold front will move through Southern Florida on Saturday keeping the chance for showers and a few thunderstorms in the forecast Saturday afternoon. The front should push south of Naples by Saturday evening with clearing skies. Cooler and less humid conditions will return Sunday with mostly sunny skies and highs in the upper 70s.
