Extended forecast – The stalled frontal boundary across Central Florida will keep Naples in an unstable atmosphere on Thursday. Scattered showers and isolated thunderstorms will be possible, especially during the afternoon hours. This front will lift further north on Friday reducing our chances for showers. Another weak cold front will move through Southern Florida on Saturday keeping the chance for showers and a few thunderstorms in the forecast Saturday afternoon. Slightly cooler and less humid conditions will return Saturday night into Sunday with clearing skies.
