Things to Know

- Webb Simpson holds the second-round lead/co-lead for the 13th time on the PGA TOUR
- Simpson made a career-best 186'7" of putts during a second-round 65
- Simpson ties career-highs on Friday for putts made from 10+, 15+ and 20+ feet
- Collin Morikawa extends made cuts streak to start his professional career to 22, second-best in last 30 years
- 62-year-old Bernhard Langer becomes the seventh player since 1970 to make the cut on the PGA TOUR at 62 or older
- Nick Watney withdrew prior to the second round after testing positive for COVID-19

Second-Round Lead Notes

- Through 23 stroke-play events this season, nine second-round leaders/co-leaders have gone on to win (most recent: Tyrrell Hatton/Arnold Palmer Invitational presented by Mastercard)
- The last second-round leader/co-leader to win the RBC Heritage was Jim Furyk in 2010
- The last nine winners of the RBC Heritage have trailed by at least two shots after 36 holes

Webb Simpson (-12/1)

- Claimed his sixth PGA TOUR victory at the 2020 Waste Management Phoenix Open
- Holds second-round lead/co-lead for 13th time in his PGA TOUR career, most recently at the 2018 Dell Technologies Championship (T49); has won twice when holding the lead/co-lead after the second round (2018 PLAYERS Championship; 2013 Shriners Hospitals for Children Open)
- First- and second-round 65s tie his low 18-hole score at RBC Heritage (40 rounds/65 – R1/R2/2020, R3/2019, R3/2013)
- Made 186'7" of putts Friday; only Brett Quigley (206'5"/R2/2003) has more in a round at the RBC Heritage since 2003
- Tied career-best for putts made from 10+ feet (8; 2019 U.S. Open/R4), 15+ feet (5; 2009 Farmers Insurance Open/R4) and 20+ feet (3; six times)
- Most top-25 finishes in an event without a victory (7 – Sony Open in Hawaii, TOUR Championship, 6 – RBC Heritage)

Additional Player Notes

- At T45, **Collin Morikawa** made his 22nd straight cut to start his professional career on the PGA TOUR, the second-longest streak to start a career in the last 30 years (longest: Tiger Woods/25)
- 62-year-old **Bernhard Langer** (T28) becomes the seventh player since 1970 to make the cut on the PGA TOUR at 62 or older; Sam Snead is the oldest to make the cut in a PGA TOUR event, doing so at the 1979 Manufacturers Hanover Westchester Classic (67 years, 2 months, 21 days)
- Canadian **Corey Connors** (T2) seeks to become the sixth international winner of the RBC Heritage in last nine years
- Last week's Charles Schwab Challenge winner **Daniel Berger** enters the weekend T28
- **Ernie Els** (T11) requires a win or solo runner-up finish to become the 11th player in PGA TOUR history to surpass \$50 million in career earnings
- Defending champion **C.T. Pan** sits T28 after opening with matching 3-under 68s; just three players have successfully defended an RBC Heritage title – Payne Stewart (1989-90), Davis Love III (1991-92) and Boo Weekley (2007-08)
- Among the players missing the cut: **Sungjae Im, Rickie Fowler, Jason Day, Patrick Reed**
