Things to Know

- Webb Simpson claims second win of 2019-20 season, sets RBC Heritage 72-hole tournament record
- Simpson moves to No. 1 in the FedExCup for the first time since the 2013-14 season
- Abraham Ancer falls a stroke shy of becoming the fifth consecutive player to earn first TOUR win at RBC Heritage
- Daniel Berger birdies three of last four holes in bid to become second player to win in back-to-back starts this season
- Tyrrell Hatton led the field in Strokes Gained: Putting in bid to win in back-to-back starts
- Dylan Frittelli posts career-low 9-under 62, one stroke shy of 18-hole tournament record

Webb Simpson – Following RBC Heritage

- Claims his seventh career PGA TOUR title in his 290th start at the age of 34 years, 10 months, 13 days
- Overtakes No. 1 position in the FedExCup standings for the fourth time in his career and first since the 2013-14 season
- Sets the 72-hole scoring record at 22-under 262, previously 20-under 264 (Brian Gay/2009)
- Win comes in 11th RBC Heritage start; previous best was second in 2013
- Has now claimed seven top-25 finishes in the event
- Has now converted four of 10 54-hole leads/co-leads into victory (2011 Wyndham Championship, 2013 Shriners Hospitals for Children Open, 2018 PLAYERS Championship, 2020 RBC Heritage)

Abraham Ancer (2nd/-21)

- Marks his second runner-up finish of the season (The American Express)
- Comes off a T14 at last week's Charles Schwab Challenge
- Led the field in Strokes Gained: Approach the Green (11.824)
- Hit a career best 65 of 72 greens in regulation; most GIR by any player at the RBC Heritage since 1980

Additional Player Notes

• **Daniel Berger** (T3/-20) was looking to become the first player to win consecutive TOUR events since Brendon Todd (2019 Bermuda Championship and Mayakoba Golf Classic)

- In five starts this season, **Tyrrell Hatton** (T3/-20) now owns four top-10s, highlighted by his first career PGA TOUR win (Arnold Palmer Invitational presented by Mastercard). Led the field in Strokes Gained: Putting (9.256)
- In his last start at the RBC Heritage, **Justin Thomas** (T8/-17) closed with an 11-over 82 to finish 75th in 2016. This week's 63 marks his 14th career round of 63 or better, the most of any player since 2015
- In his bid to become the fourth player to successfully defend his RBC Heritage title and first since Boo Weekley in 2008, **C.T. Pan** finished T52 at 9-under 275
