Today – Partly cloudy, hot and humid conditions can be expected today with highs in the mid 80s. Scattered thunderstorms will be possible again this afternoon as the sea breeze moves inland. Storms will be slow moving and could produce heavy rainfall in a short period of time. Otherwise, light wind this morning will increase out of the south 7-14 mph as the sea breeze moves inland this afternoon.

Extended forecast – Hot and humid conditions will continue through early next week as a weak area of high pressure builds over the region Sunday into Monday. This will likely decrease the chances for scattered showers and thunderstorms, but can't rule out an isolated thunderstorm developing during the afternoon hours. Temperatures should reach the upper 80s each day along the coast with low 90s expected inland.
