Things to Know

- With a win, Matthew Wolff would become the youngest two-time PGA TOUR winner since Tiger Woods
- Wolff has made the most birdies and eagles (25) through 54 holes of any player at any tournament this season
- Bryson DeChambeau is in contention to earn his seventh consecutive top-10 finish and sixth career win
- After making an ace in the second round, Ryan Armour seeks second PGA TOUR victory in 179th career start

- 1 Third-round leader/co-leader at the Rocket Mortgage Classic to win (Nate Lashley/2019)
- 15 Third-round leaders/co-leaders to win on PGA TOUR in 2019-20 (most recent: Webb Simpson, RBC Heritage)

Matthew Wolff (1st/-19)

- Second career 54-hole lead/co-lead; converted the previous instance into victory at the 2019 3M Open
- With a win, would become the youngest two-time PGA TOUR winner (21 years, 2 months, 21 days) since Tiger Woods (20 years, 9 months, 20 days)
- Made the most birdies and eagles (25) through 54 holes of any player at any tournament this season
- Set his low 54-hole total with 197 (previous: 198/2019 3M Open en route to victory)
- Carded two rounds of 64 or better this week (entering the week: one round of 64 or better in 73 rounds)
- Seeking first top-10 finish since maiden TOUR victory at the 2019 3M Open
- Missed the cut at 2019 Rocket Mortgage Classic with rounds of 75-68

Bryson DeChambeau (T2/-16)

- Seeking sixth TOUR victory and first since 2018 Shriners Hospitals for Children Open

- In contention to earn his seventh consecutive top-10 finish (T5/The Genesis Invitational, 2nd/WGC-Mexico Championship, 4th/Arnold Palmer Invitational presented by Mastercard, T3/Charles Schwab Challenge, T8/RBC Heritage, T6/Travelers Championship)
- Is the only player to finish in the top 10 in each of the three events since season resumed
- Leads the field in Driving Distance (347.3 yards) and Strokes Gained: Off the Tee (5.995)

Ryan Armour (T2/-16)

- Missed six consecutive cuts prior to the cancellation of THE PLAYERS Championship in March, but made the cut in all starts since the season resumed (T74/RBC Heritage, T6/Travelers Championship, TBD/Rocket Mortgage Classic)
- In the second round, made an ace on the par-3 fifth hole from 157 yards with an 8-iron
- Seeking second PGA TOUR victory (2017 Sanderson Farms Championship)

Additional Player Notes

- **Mark Hubbard** (T4/-14) is looking for maiden TOUR victory in Rocket Mortgage Classic debut (best career finish: T2/2019 Houston Open); leads the TOUR in rounds in the 60s (40)
- **Troy Merritt** (T4/-14) is the only player without a bogey through 54 holes, marking the first time in his career to do so
- 36-hole co-leader and FedExCup leader **Webb Simpson** (T8/-13) seeks second consecutive victory and looks to become the first three-time winner of the 2019-20 season
