Defending champion Nate Lashley claimed his first victory in his 33rd PGA TOUR start at this event last season. Lashley became the first alternate to win on the PGA TOUR since Vaughn Taylor (2016 AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am). Currently ranks 61st in the FedExCup standings on the strength of two top-10s in 14 starts compared to 123rd with one top-10 in eight starts at this point in the 2018-19 season.
