Things to Know

- The Sanderson Farms Championship has served as the first PGA TOUR victory for each of the last five winners
- Sebastian Munoz poised to collect first win after bogey-free 9-under 63
- One, two and three strokes back, respectively, Carlos Ortiz, Byeong Hun An and Cameron Person also in position for first career victory on the PGA TOUR
- Since moving to the Country Club of Jackson in 2014, the only two 54-hole leaders/co-leaders to convert for the win have been Ryan Armour (2017) and Cameron Champ (2018)
- Defending champion Cameron Champ is at 7-under 209 in bid to become first tournament winner to successfully defend

Sebastian Munoz (1st/-16)

- Birdied his first three holes before posting the week’s low score of (a bogey-free) 9-under 63. Career-low is 61
- Nine birdies in round three matches his total number of birdies from the first two rounds
- His 9-under 63 falls one stroke shy of the Country Club of Jackson course record, set by Roberto Castro in round one of 2016
- On only other occasion to hold a 54-hole lead, finished T3 at the 2017 A Military Tribute at The Greenbrier after a final-round 2-over 72
- Hit eight of 14 fairways and 16 of 18 greens in regulation in round three
- Making his third start in the Sanderson Farms Championship: 2018/T50, 2016/T35
- Comes off a T7 finish at last week’s A Military Tribute at The Greenbrier
- On the strength of three top-10 finishes, advanced to the FedExCup Playoffs for the first time. Finished 117th in FedExCup
- Best PGA TOUR finish is T3 from the 2017 A Military Tribute at The Greenbrier
- The Sanderson Farms Championship has served as the first PGA TOUR victory for each of the last five winners; Cameron Champ/2018, Ryan Armour/2017, Cody Gribble/2016, Peter Malnati/2015 and Nick Taylor/2015. Since the start of the ShotLink era in 2003, the longest streak of first-time winners in an event is six (Shriners Hospitals for Children Open)

Carlos Ortiz (2nd/-15)

- Made five birdies and an eagle at the par-5 11th en route to a bogey-free 7-under 65
- Hit 11 of 14 fairways and 17 of 18 greens in regulation
- In only other Sanderson Farms Championship start, posted a final-round 8-under 64 last season to post his career-best finish of T3
- On the strength of three top-10 finishes in the 2018-19 season, advanced to the FedExCup Playoffs. Finished his season 113th in the FedExCup
- Seeks his first career PGA TOUR victory in his 92nd start

Byeong Hun An (3rd/-14)

- Followed three consecutive birdies on Nos. 13-15 with back-to-back bogeys at 16 and 17 en route to a 2-under 70
- Seeks his first career PGA TOUR title in his 98th TOUR start. Has finished T2 three times on the PGA TOUR, most recently at the 2018 RBC Canadian Open
- Making his tournament debut at the Sanderson Farms Championship
- Recorded three top-10 finishes during the 2018-19 PGA TOUR Season, eventually finishing 53rd in the FedExCup

Miscellaneous Notes

- Making his 138th career start on the PGA TOUR, Australia's Cameron Percy in position for first TOUR victory
- A win Sunday for J.T. Poston (T5/-12) would come in his third start since victory in Greensboro, the fewest events between wins since Matt Kuchar won the 2019 Sony Open in Hawaii three starts after his 2018 Mayakoba Golf Classic title
- Dylan Frittelli (T13/-9) aced his first hole of the day, No. 10, using a 3-iron from 224 yards
