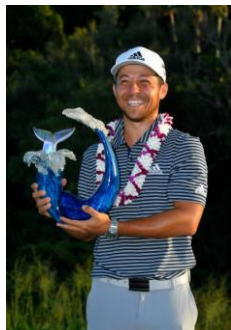

### ShotLink Keys to Victory - Xander Schauffele



Xander Schauffele recorded his fourth PGA TOUR win in his 61<sup>st</sup> career start and earned 500 FedExCup points. Schauffele moved to the #1 spot in the FedExCup standings, which marked the fourth week Xander has led the FedExCup in his career.

Xander Schauffele has birdied the 72<sup>nd</sup> hole to either win by one stroke or get into a playoff in each of his four career PGA TOUR victories.

**5 strokes:** Xander Schauffele came from five strokes back entering the final round to win the 2019 Sentry Tournament of Champions, marking the largest final round come-from-behind victory at the Plantation Course at Kapalua since 1999 (previous was four strokes).

**2 Eagles in Final Rd:** Xander Schauffele made two eagles, eight birdies and one bogey en route to a final round 62. Schauffele became the first player since Jon Rahm (2017 Farmers Insurance Open) to make two eagles in the final round en route to victory on the PGA TOUR.
