



**Sunday** – Tropical Storm Arthur is located about 200 miles east of Jacksonville this morning and will continue to track northeast towards the Outer Banks of North Carolina. A light west wind this morning will allow temperatures to climb into the upper 80s in Juno Beach before a southeast sea breeze develops around 3pm. Scattered thunderstorms are forecast to develop near Lake Okeechobee this afternoon and track towards the coast by late in the afternoon. Will have to monitor for scattered thunderstorms in Juno beach between 4pm-8pm today with thunderstorm chances around 30 percent.
