










Some of these clouds could drift towards the course before 9am, otherwise another day of dry conditions and mostly sunny skies will occur. Temperatures should reach the 63-65F range before the sea breeze with southwesterly winds at 4-9 mph, gusting to 12 mph this afternoon.
