Things to Know

- Jon Rahm earns his fourth PGA TOUR victory and becomes the fourth player with wins in each of the last four seasons (others: Bryson DeChambeau, Dustin Johnson, Justin Thomas)
- Rahm moves to No. 1 in the OWGR for the first time in his career, becoming the 24th player to reach that mark
- Under Rule 9.4, Rahm was assessed a General Penalty (two strokes) after a ball at rest moved on the par-3 16th
- Ryan Palmer, Rahm's teammate for 2019 Zurich Classic of New Orleans victory, earns his 10th career runner-up
- Palmer and Mackenzie Hughes qualify for the 2020 U.S. Open as the top two players, not otherwise exempt, in the top 10 and ties
- The final-round scoring average (75.959) is the highest at a non-major since the 2016 Farmers Insurance Open

Jon Rahm (Won/-9)

- Earns fourth PGA TOUR victory in his 85th start at the age of 25 years, 8 months, 9 days (wins: 2017 Farmers Insurance Open, 2018 The American Express, 2019 Zurich Classic of New Orleans, 2020 the Memorial Tournament presented by Nationwide)
- Moves to No. 1 in the Official World Golf Ranking for the first time in his career and No. 8 in the FedExCup standings
- 24th player to reach the No. 1 position in the OWGR all-time
- Fifth-youngest player to reach the No. 1 position in the OWGR (25 years, 251 days); Tiger Woods, Jordan Spieth, Rory McIlroy and Justin Thomas did so at a younger age
- Second player from Spain to reach the No. 1 position in the OWGR (first: Seve Ballesteros)
- Becomes the fourth player with at least one win in each of the last four PGA TOUR seasons, joining Bryson DeChambeau, Dustin Johnson and Justin Thomas

• Improves to 1-for-3 converting 54-hole lead/co-lead to victory (T12/2019 THE PLAYERS Championship, 2nd/2020 Farmers Insurance Open, Won/2020 the Memorial Tournament presented by Nationwide)

Ryan Palmer (2nd/-6)

- 10th career runner-up and first since losing in a playoff at the 2018 Farmers Insurance Open
- Qualifies for the 2020 U.S. Open as one of the top two players, not otherwise exempt, in the top 10 and ties
- Fourth top-10 of the season (T10/ZOZO CHAMPIONSHIP, T4/Sony Open in Hawaii, T8/RBC Heritage, 2nd/the Memorial Tournament)
- Led the field in Strokes Gained: Approach The Green (10.218 cumulative)
- Sixth Memorial Tournament start and first since missing the cut in 2011

Additional Notes

- In the final rounds of the Arnold Palmer Invitational presented by Mastercard and the Memorial Tournament presented by Nationwide, there were two total scores in the 60s; **Matthew Fitzpatrick** (T3) recorded both of them (69/Arnold Palmer Invitational, 68/the Memorial Tournament)
- In his third attempt at a record-breaking 83rd PGA TOUR victory, five-time Memorial Tournament winner **Tiger Woods** shot a final-round 76 to finish T40
- Defending champion **Patrick Cantlay** finished T32
- **Ryan Palmer** (2nd) and **Mackenzie Hughes** (T6) qualify for the 2020 U.S. Open as the top two players, not otherwise exempt, in the top 10 and ties
- The final-round scoring average of 75.959 is the highest in a round on the PGA TOUR since the 2018 U.S. Open (76.474/R1) and the highest at a non-major since the 2016 Farmers Insurance Open (77.901/R4)
