# **Things To Know**

- Scottie Scheffler shot the 12<sup>th</sup> sub-60 round in PGA TOUR history with a 12-under-par 59; 11<sup>th</sup> player to do so
- Dustin Johnson shot a career-low round with an 11-under-par 60 to take a two-stroke lead
- Johnson matched the lowest 9-hole score in relation to par on the PGA TOUR with a 9-under-par 27 on the front nine
- Johnson's 127 total sets the course record and matches the tournament record for opening 36 holes
- Pat Perez withdrew during round 2 due to an ankle injury joining Brooks Koepka/before the 1<sup>st</sup> round (knee/hip injury), Vaughn Taylor/before 1<sup>st</sup> round (rib injury), Ryan Moore/during 1<sup>st</sup> round (back injury)
- Two-time FedExCup champions Tiger Woods and Rory McIlroy finished the second round at 3-under par, making the cut on the number and will be paired together for the third round

# Dustin Johnson (1st/67-60—127)

- Shot career-low round with 11-under-par 60 to take a two-shot lead.
- Was 11-under-par through 11 holes before making par on the final seven holes of his round
- Set the course record at TPC Boston for 36-hole score of 127 and matched the tournament record with Bob Gilder in 1982 at Westchester Country Club
- Matched low 9-hole score in relation to par on the PGA TOUR at 9-under-par matching five other players, most recently, Ryan Palmer at the 2015 American Express

- Two-time champion at THE NORTHERN TRUST, with victories at the weather-shortened three-round 2011 event at Plainfield Country Club and in a playoff against Jordan Spieth in 2017 at Glenn Oaks Club
- One of seven players to win THE NORTHERN TRUST two or more times. With a third win would join Vijay Singh (four wins) with three or more victories at this event
- Has finished in the top 30 in the standings each of the last 11 seasons
- Won the Travelers Championship earlier this year to extend his streak to 13 seasons with at least one victory
- Shot his previous low-career round enroute to victory at the Travelers Championship with a 61 in the third round
- Marks the 19<sup>th</sup> time Dustin Johnson holds or shares the 36-hole lead and the first since THE NORTHERN TRUST in 2019.
- Has converted nine of 18 second-round leads into victory, the last coming at the 2019 WGC-Mexico Championship
- Recorded two or more eagles in the same round for the 12<sup>th</sup> time since 2008, the most of any player on TOUR

# Scottie Scheffler (T2/70-59—129)

- 11th different player to shoot a sub-60 round on the PGA TOUR and 11<sup>th</sup> 59 (Jim Furyk has broken 60 twice)
- Last player to shoot 59 or better was Kevin Chappell at the 2019 Military Tribute at The Greenbrier (59)
- Score of 59 breaks the course record at TPC Boston (61 Vijay Singh/2006, Mike Weir/2008) and tournament 18-hole scoring record (61-Brandt Snedeker-round 3-Plainfield CC)
- Enters the week at No. 24 in the FedExCup standings, the highest-ranked rookie in the standings this season

# Cameron Davis (T2/64-65—129)

- 2018-19 PGA TOUR rookie has 15 birdies through first two rounds and is tied for second, two off the lead
- 2020 THE NORTHERN TRUST marks the 25-year-old Australian's FedExCup Playoffs debut
- Entered the week at No. 91 in the FedExCup standings as he looks to move into the top 70 to continue on to the BMW Championship

- Following four consecutive missed cuts on TOUR this season, finished inside the top 15 in two of his last three starts (3M Open/T12, Wyndham Championship/T15)
- Has collected two top-10 finishes in 49 TOUR starts; 2020 Sony Open in Hawaii/T9, 2020 The Honda Classic/T8

### **Miscellaneous Player Notes**

- With a missed cut at THE NORTHERN TRUST, **Phil Mickelson** is currently projected to finish 76<sup>th</sup> in the FedExCup standings, meaning he would miss the BMW Championship for the fist time in his career, ending a streak of 13 consecutive seasons reaching the penultimate Playoffs event since the inception of the FedExCup in 2007. His previous worst finish in the standings came in 2014 when he finished 68<sup>th</sup>.
- Russell Henley (T7/-11) and Louis Oosthuizen (T4/-12) are both bogey-free through the first 36 holes.
- 2007, 2009 FedExCup champion **Tiger Woods** (T58/-3) is seeking a record-breaking 83<sup>rd</sup> TOUR title. Collected five top-10 finishes at TPC Boston in the Dell Technologies Championship, highlighted by a win in 2006. After five starts this season, begins the week at No. 49 in the FedExCup
- 2016 and 2019 THE NORTHERN TRUST champion **Patrick Reed** (T58/3-under-par) seeks to become the first player to successfully defend his title since Ernie Els in 1997. Currently sixth in the FedExCup
- Top five players in the FedExCup standings: 1/Justin Thomas (T20/-7), 2/Collin Morikawa (MC), 3/Webb Simpson (T18/-8), 4/Bryson DeChambeau (MC), 5/Sungjae Im (MC)
- After THE NORTHERN TRUST, the top 70 players in the FedExCup standings advance to next week's BMW Championship
