Things To Know

- Dustin Johnson takes 54-hole lead/co-lead for the 22nd time on TOUR; has converted to a victory 11 times (most recent: 2019 World Golf Championships-Mexico Championship)
- Johnson's 191 sets the course record at TPC Boston and marks the tournament record for opening 54 holes
- Tyrrell Hatton (T9/-12) made 10 birdies en route to an 8-under 63, marks career-most birdies in one round on the PGA TOUR (previously eight birdies, most recent: 2020 RBC Heritage/R3)
- Two-time FedExCup champions Tiger Woods (67/-1) and Rory McIlroy (68/E) will be paired together for the final round

Dustin Johnson (1st/67-60 -64—191)

- Marks 22nd time to hold 54-hole lead/co-lead and has converted to a victory 11 times (most recent: 2019 WGC-Mexico Championship)
 - 54-hole events: 2011 THE NORTHERN TRUST, 2013 Sentry Tournament of Champions, 2009 AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am
- Holds a 73%-win percentage when ahead by three or more strokes headed into the final round of a PGA TOUR event (eight of 11)
- Set the course record at TPC Boston for 54-hole score of 191 and broke the previous tournament record (his own) for best 54-hole score (previously: 194/2011/Plainfield Country Club)
- His 5-stroke lead marks the largest 54-hole lead on TOUR this season (previously: four strokes, Jon Rahm/the Memorial Tournament presented by Nationwide)

- Ties the lowest first 54-hole score on TOUR this season (Kevin Na/Shriners Hospitals for Children Open)
- His 22-under-par marks his best score to par through opening three rounds on TOUR (most recent: 19-under-par at THE 2011 NORTHERN TRUST/Plainfield Country Club)
- Two-time champion at THE NORTHERN TRUST, with victories at the weather-shortened three-round event in 2011 event at Plainfield Country Club and in a playoff against Jordan Spieth in 2017 at Glenn Oaks Club
- One of seven players to win THE NORTHERN TRUST two or more times. With a third win, would join Vijay Singh (four) with three or more victories at this event
- Has finished in the top 30 in the standings each of the last 11 seasons
- Won the Travelers Championship earlier this year to extend his streak to 13 seasons with at least one victory

Miscellaneous Player Notes

- Scottie Scheffler (T2/-17) followed a 12-under 59 in round two with a 4-under 67 in his FedExCup Playoffs debut; entered the week at No. 24 in the FedExCup standings and the highest-ranked rookie in the standings
- After notching bogey-free rounds through the first 36 holes, **Louis Oosthuizen** (4/-15), made three bogeys in round three but countered with six birdies to shoot a 3-under 68
- 2019-20 PGA TOUR rookie **Harry Higgs** has 19 birdies and three bogeys through the first three rounds and sits T5 in his FedExCup Playoffs debut. He started the week at No. 72 in the FedExCup standings and is projected to finish No. 34.
- Tyrrell Hatton (T9/-12) made 10 birdies en route to an 8-under 63, marks career-most birdies in one round (previously eight birdies, most recent: 2020 RBC Heritage/R3). Made birdie on all par-3 holes (Nos. 3, 8, 11, 17) for first time in his career (minimum of four par-3 holes played)
- 2016 and 2019 THE NORTHERN TRUST champion Patrick Reed sits at T51 (-3)
- After THE NORTHERN TRUST, the top 70 players in the FedExCup standings advance to next week's BMW Championship
