### **Things To Know**

- In winning third THE NORTHERN TRUST title, Dustin Johnson moves to World No. 1 and FedExCup No. 1
- Johnson claims fifth FedExCup Playoffs title, tying Rory McIlroy for most
- Johnson's 30-under falls a stroke short of the PGA TOUR record for most strokes under par
- Harris English finishes second, best of six consecutive top-25 finishes on the PGA TOUR this season
- Kevin Kisner closes with a bogey-free 66 to finish T3 for the second week in a row
- Jon Rahm finishes T6, his third top-6 showing in four starts at THE NORTHERN TRUST
- Six players fell out of the top-70, moving six in to earn spots into this week's BMW Championship
- 2007, 2009 FedExCup champion Tiger Woods closes with 66 to finish T58 in his 11<sup>th</sup> THE NORTHERN TRUST start

- Posts a bogey-free 8-under 63 to claim his 22<sup>nd</sup> career PGA TOUR victory and third at THE NORTHERN TRUST (2011, 2017, 2020) in his 272<sup>nd</sup> start at the age of 36 years, 2 months, 1 day
- Joins Vijay Singh (four) as players with three-or-more THE NORTHERN TRUST titles
- 30-under total falls a stroke shy of the all-time TOUR record for most strokes under par in a 72-hole event (-31/Ernie Els/2003 Sentry Tournament of Champions)
- 254 total falls a stroke short of lowest total score in a 72-hole event (253/Justin Thomas/2017 Sony Open in Hawaii)
- 11-stroke win supplants his previous biggest winning margin of eight shots (2018 Sentry Tournament of Champions)
- Marks his fifth FedExCup Playoffs title (2010, 2016 BMW Championship), tying him with Rory McIlroy for most
- Moves from 15<sup>th</sup> to 1<sup>st</sup> in the FedExCup standings by a margin of 92 points over Justin Thomas
- Best finish in the FedExCup is second (2016)

- Winner of 2020 Travelers Championship, this marks his sixth multiple-win season on TOUR; has never collected more than two wins in a season
- Joins Justin Thomas (3), Brendon Todd (2), Webb Simpson (2) and Collin Morikawa (2) as multiple winners this season
- Has collected at least one victory in 13 consecutive seasons
- Converts for the win for a 12<sup>th</sup> time when holding 54-hole lead/co-lead (22 tries); 2011 THE NORTHERN TRUST, 2013 Sentry Tournament of Champions, 2009 AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am were reduced to 54 holes (inclement weather)
- Made five eagles during the week; par-5 18<sup>th</sup> (R1, R3), par-5 second (R2, R4), par-4 fourth (R2)
- Played TPC Boston's front nine in 18-under (14 birdies, 3 eagles, 2 birdies)
- Hit all 18 greens in regulation for the second time of his career (2017 Sentry Tournament of Champions/R4)
- Will extend his streak of season-ending TOUR Championship appearances to 12

### **Miscellaneous Player Notes**

- With his runner-up finish, Harris English claims a sixth consecutive top-25 finish this season. Moves to sixth in the FedExCup
- Kevin Kisner closes with a bogey-free 66 to finish T3 for the second week in a row (Wyndham Championship)
- Following his second-round 12-under 59, **Scottie Scheffler** finishes T4 in his FedExCup Playoffs debut; entered the week at No. 24 in the FedExCup standings and the highest-ranked rookie in the standings and moves to No. 14
- First-Year PGA TOUR Member **Robby Shelton** (T13/-13) played his last six holes in 6-under (B-B-E-P-B-B) to post 8-under 63, one stroke shy of his career low; jumps from 81<sup>st</sup> in the FedExCup to 62<sup>nd</sup>, good for a berth into the BMW Championship
- Jon Rahm (T6/-16) claims a third top-5 finish in fourth THE NORTHERN TRUST start (T3/2017, 2019). Sits ninth in the FedExCup
- Jason Kokrak (T13/-13) moved from 90<sup>th</sup> in the FedExCup into the top 70 (66<sup>th</sup>) by virtue of an eagle-3 at the 72<sup>nd</sup> hole
- Louis Oosthuizen (T13/-13) birdied the 72<sup>nd</sup> hole after the rain delay to secure the last spot in the top 70
- In his 11 start at THE NORTHERN TRUST, 2007, 2009 FedExCup champion **Tiger Woods** (T58/-6) birdied his first four holes en route to a final-round 5-under 66; heads into this week's BMW Championship at No. 57 in the FedExCup standings
- 2016 and 2019 THE NORTHERN TRUST champion Patrick Reed finished T49 at 7-under 277; No. 10 in the FedExCup
- The top 70 players in the FedExCup standings advance to this week's BMW Championship at Olympia Fields
