Today – Dry conditions are forecast through the morning hours, with scattered thunderstorms possible after 1-2pm this afternoon – focusing along a sea breeze that will be drifting in from the east. Locally heavy downpours and brief gusty outflow winds will be possible with these afternoon storms. Winds will shift in direction through the day, becoming east-southeasterly behind the sea breeze late this afternoon. The temperature will reach a high in the upper 80s.

Rainfall: 0.10" – 0.25", locally higher in thunderstorms.

Tomorrow – Areas of fog are expected Sunday morning, but these areas are likely to burn off between 7-8am. A few thunderstorms may materialize after 2pm Sunday, but the coverage will be lower than Saturday and a washout is not expected. Otherwise expect another humid day with temperatures topping out in the upper 80s. **Rainfall: 0.05" – 0.10", locally higher in any thunderstorms.**
