Today – Dry conditions this morning under sunny to mostly sunny skies. An isolated to widely scattered coverage of showers and thunderstorms is forecast to develop after 2pm this afternoon. Although the radar will likely become active across Central Massachusetts and the North Shore during the late afternoon and into the evening, shower and storm coverage should remain lower near TPC Boston. This more active weather north/west of TPC Boston should fade in intensity as it drifts southeastward after sunset. Warm and muggy conditions otherwise, with a high temperature in the upper 80s.

Rainfall: 0.05" – 0.10", locally higher in any thunderstorms.
