Winds will switch from north-northwesterly this morning to west-southwesterly this afternoon but will remain quite light throughout the day. The temperature will top out around 80 degrees.

Extended forecast – Surface high pressure will keep conditions dry on Friday, with southwesterly winds becoming slightly breezy in the afternoon. Low-end chances for afternoon showers and thunderstorms return this weekend ahead of a cold front that is expected to drop in from the north on Monday. Shower and storm coverage should remain isolated on Saturday, while a widely scattered coverage is expected on Sunday – with neither day likely to see a washout. High temperatures will be in the 80s throughout the tournament week.
