RSM Classic Charles Howell III

ShotLink Keys to Victory - Charles Howell III

Charles Howell III recorded his third PGA TOUR win in his 529th start and earned 500 FedExCup points.

Howell III moved from 62nd to 1st in the FedExCup standings and for the first time since 2007.

Charles Howell III won on the second playoff hole, defeating Patrick Rodgers. After starting his round three-over par through his first four holes, Howell played his last 14 holes six-under par (in regulation).

Charles Howell III gained +0.717 strokes in SG: Putting on the Seaside Course, including gaining +1.91 strokes on his final 14 holes in regulation in the final round.

Charles Howell III opened the 2018 RSM Classic hitting every fairway and every green for the first time in his career on TOUR and failed to make a bogey through his first 39 holes. Howell III hit 64 total Greens in Regulation, marking his third most total greens hit in regulation in a four-round PGA TOUR event.

On his last 14 holes in regulation, Charles Howell III gained +1.43 strokes tee to green and +1.91 on the greens in strokes gained.

Brendon Todd

Current FedExCup leader Brendon Todd recorded his third PGA TOUR win at the Mayakoba Golf Classic last week. Brendon is set to make his sixth start at the RSM Classic with his best finish coming in 2013, t-16.

Fast Facts about Brendon Todd:

- Bumped out Tiger Woods to claim a spot inside the PGA TOURs top-10
- Had his best FEC season in 2014 finishing 27th
- Became the 63rd player to rank #1 in the FedExCup standings
- Was his 11th week ranking inside top-10 of the FedExCup in any week
- First time inside top-10 since week #36 in the 2013-14 season (span of 229 weeks)
- Is the 13th player to move inside of the top-10 after the first week of the season
