



Today – Partly cloudy skies can be expected today with highs in the low 90s. It will become more humid as a weak cold front slowly drops south into N Georgia this afternoon. The front will sag into the Atlanta metro this evening and could produce an isolated shower or t-storm as it passes. Otherwise the higher likelihood for seeing thunderstorm activity will remain across N Georgia today.

Extended forecast – The front will stall across South-Central Georgia this weekend as high pressure builds into the area from the north. This will allow slightly cooler and less humid conditions to return, especially Sunday into Monday. Any thunderstorm activity should remain south of Atlanta this weekend closer to the stalled front. Otherwise partly cloudy skies can be expected with highs in the upper 80s and lows in the 60s.
