Things To Know

- Dustin Johnson claims 21st PGA TOUR title; extends streak of at least one title to 13 consecutive seasons
- Johnson's T79 position marks the lowest first-round position by a winner of the Travelers Championship since 1983
- 2014 Travelers Championship winner Kevin Streelman posts 14th consecutive round in the 60s at Travelers Championship
- Playing on a sponsor exemption, Will Gordon finishes T3, earns Special Temporary Membership to PGA TOUR
- 18-hole leader Mackenzie Hughes sinks 47'9" and 43'7" birdie putts at 17 and 18, respectively, for season's second top-5 finish
- Triple bogey at No. 12 sidelines 54-hole leader Brendon Todd's bid for third win of 2019-20 TOUR Season; finishes T11

- Followed his lowest opening 54-hole total (194) on the PGA TOUR with a 3-under 67 to claim his 21st title in his 267th start six days removed from his 36th birthday
- With the win, moves to No. 22 in the FedExCup standings; has advanced to the season-ending TOUR Championship 10 of the last 11 seasons (2014)
- His T79 after round one marks the lowest first-round position by a winner of the Travelers Championship since 1983
- Of 19 stroke-play events won before this week, had never been lower than T28 after the first round
- With the win, extends his streak of winning at least one PGA TOUR event to 13 consecutive seasons
- Victory comes in his fourth appearance at the Travelers Championship; 2020/1st, 2014/T31, 2009/WD, 2008/T34
- Win marks his third top-10 finish in seven starts this season (T7/Sentry Tournament of Champions, T10/The Genesis Invitational) and 99th of his TOUR career
- Since the PGA TOUR's Return to Golf, followed a pair of 71s at the Charles Schwab Challenge (MC) with eight consecutive rounds in the 60s. Finished T17 at the 2020 RBC Heritage

Kevin Streelman (2nd/-18)

- 2014 Travelers Championship winner closed with a 3-under 67 to finish one stroke back. Began the day three shots off the pace thanks to a 7-under 63 in round three
- En route to 2014 victory at TPC River Highlands, overcame a 6-stroke deficit beginning the inward nine with birdies on his last seven holes to win by one stroke over K.J. Choi and Sergio Garcia
- In 13 Travelers Championship starts, has now collected five top-10 finishes
- Was in search of his third career PGA TOUR title and first since the 2014 Travelers Championship (first won the 2013 Valspar Championship)
- 2020 Travelers Championship marks his second runner-up finish of the season (AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am)
- In last two starts before the Travelers Championship, missed the cut at the Charles Schwab Challenge and RBC Heritage

Additional Notes

- **Brendon Todd** (T11/-13), who led by two strokes after 54 holes at 18-under 192, followed a career-low 9-under 61 with a 5-over 75. Following just one bogey through the first 65 holes, took a triple-bogey-seven at No. 12 and bogeys at Nos. 14 and 18 to dash his chances at a third TOUR title this season
- Playing on a sponsor exemption in his eighth PGA TOUR event, **Will Gordon's** T3 finish at 17-under 263 earns him enough non-member FedExCup points to qualify for unlimited sponsor exemptions as a Special Temporary Member of the PGA TOUR. By virtue of the top-10 finish at the Travelers Championship, earns a spot into this week's field at the Rocket Mortgage Classic (previously in on a sponsor exemption)
- 18-hole leader **Mackenzie Hughes** (T3/-17) sank birdie putts on Nos. 17 and 18 from 47'9" and 43'7", respectively, to claim his second top-5 finish of the 2019-20 season (2nd/The Honda Classic)
- In his third start at the Travelers Championship, World No. 1 **Rory McIlroy** closed with a 3-under 67 to finish T11 at 13-under 267. Marks just the third occasion of finishing outside the top 10 this season (nine starts), with all three coming in Return to Golf events
- 2001-02 Travelers Championship winner and 36-hole leader **Phil Mickelson** finished T24 at 11-under 269 in his seventh Travelers Championship start
