Extended forecast – Showers and thunderstorms are expected to continue this evening into tonight but should diminish to a scattered coverage after midnight. Scattered showers and isolated thunderstorm will remain possible Saturday morning as a low pressure system rotates over western Tennessee. Outside a slim risk for a pop-up shower Sunday afternoon, dry conditions are expected for the final round with temperatures rising into the mid-80s.
