Today – A few passing showers are expected through mid-morning, with a low threat of an embedded thunderstorm. The late morning to early afternoon hours may see a few thunderstorms develop as a weak wave passes overhead, then a lull in activity should take place for a few hours before additional thunderstorms begin to develop over northwestern Tennessee and drift towards TPC Southwind this evening. The heat index will rise above 100F by early this afternoon.

Sunrise: 6:07am / Sunset: 8:03pm Rainfall through 7pm: 0.10" – 0.25"; locally higher in any T-storms.

Extended forecast – Showers and thunderstorms will remain a possibility on Friday morning as a frontal boundary stalls just north of the area. With plentiful moisture in place and instability forecast to build through the afternoon, expect thunderstorms to increase in coverage along the frontal boundary, with the highest chances arriving after 4pm. Thunderstorms are then likely to continue overnight into Saturday morning. A low pressure system will rotate overhead on Saturday, keeping scattered rounds of rain and storms in the forecast. A cold front will move through at some point on Saturday afternoon – likely bringing quieter conditions for much of Sunday outside a few afternoon pop-up showers or weak storms.
