**Extended forecast** – A trough of low pressure will be approaching the Carolinas on Saturday producing numerous showers and thunderstorms, especially during the afternoon and evening hours. Heavy rainfall will be possible at times. The trough is expected to slowly move to the east on Sunday allowing for drier air and lower humidity to return as we go through the day. There is still a chance for scattered showers and a few thunderstorms across the area but will depend on the exact location of the trough. Partly cloudy skies return on Monday with a small chance for an afternoon thunderstorm with highs in the mid 80s.
