**Today** – Cloudy skies will hang tough through the morning hours with some peeks of sunshine slowly returning as we go through the afternoon. Temperatures around 64 degrees to start the day will gradually rise into the low 70s by midday and into the upper 70s this afternoon. Can't rule out an isolated shower developing this afternoon, but most locations will remain dry.
