Today – A weakening band of light rain should dissipate by the start of the first round. Otherwise mostly cloudy and muggy conditions can be expected this morning before showers and thunderstorms redevelop this afternoon. Any thunderstorm activity will be slow moving and will likely produce heavy rainfall and possible flash flooding in a short period of time today.

Extended forecast – No changes to the extended forecast as a wet weather pattern sets up over the Carolinas. A tropical air mass will combine with a weak trough of low pressure to produce numerous showers and thunderstorms, especially during the afternoon and evening hours each day through the weekend. Showers and storms will be slow moving and capable of producing heavy rainfall in a short period of time. 1.5-3 inches of rain will be possible on average through Sunday.
