BOB ESTES: Yeah, first tournament. The finish was really good. My game was a little bit sloppy every day, so I definitely have some things I can work on and try to tidy up. And I need to hit it better. I've got a new driver in the bag, which is a really good driver, but I probably don't have the setup quite the way it needs to be. I was pretty good for this week. And I'll have a little different setup, because I'm going to hit it a little bit longer and a little bit higher when we go to Tucson. So it was pretty good for this week. And I putted pretty well for the most part also. So I just managed my game well and shot some good scores.
