

Q. Great start today. Take us through your round a little bit.

SCOTT PAREL: I had a lot of good, solid shots today. I putted the ball well. Saw the lines really well today. Bogey I made on 7 was huge. I lost the ball in a palm tree. Hit a good tee shot, hit it in front, and chipped in for a 5, so that was a huge momentum. Even though it was a bogey, it could be six or seven easily. And I wasn't that concerned. That was really the only really bad tee shot I hit all day, so it was good.

Q. How did you play last year here?

SCOTT PAREL: I think I played okay the first two days, but then the last day I didn't play well at all. Maybe shot like even par the last day, which is -- you're going to get lapped down here on this Tour, so --

Q. This course, yeah.

SCOTT PAREL: Well, any course that we play, unless it's the U.S. Open or something.

But I liked the golf course last year. I just -- I don't think I -- I felt like I got out of position a little more last year. Today I felt like I was -- off the tee I was in good spots where you're going to have some wedges. And the greens are so perfect. They're just like my greens that I'm used to at home, so --

Q. There you go.
