

BERNHARD LANGER (-10)

Q. How was the weather today for you? The wind play any factor in your game?

BERNHARD LANGER: Definitely. It's a much tougher wind for this course, I think, the north wind. Yeah, so it was southwest, so it played almost the opposite. Par 5s are a lot harder today than yesterday. I reached all the par 5s yesterday, today I only reached one. Just a harder wind for some reason the way the holes lay out. And the wind was up a little bit, too. I think yesterday was probably 10 miles an hour, I think today was more like 15 to 20.

Q. Did your putter come through in the times that you needed it to?

BERNHARD LANGER: No, I was really, really struggling. Missed three or four fairly short putts early on. Then finally made a shortish one on 15, then made a very long one on 16, probably 40 feet or so, so that helped a little bit. Made up for one or two of the short ones I missed. But yeah, that was the frustrating part, it's just hard to putt in the wind, too.

Q. Woody said the ones who went out early went low, the ones who went out late just kind of maintained. So now it's all jammed up and pretty tight. Tomorrow, just go out and do the best you can?

BERNHARD LANGER: Yeah, that's what we do every day, but I haven't even had a chance to look at the leaderboard so I don't know what is what.

Q. It's tight.

BERNHARD LANGER: Yeah, I figured it would be. It's just I think putting into the grain is very hard. You know, the greens are a little slower than normal and then the ball starts bouncing around and it's hard to keep it online. But just hopefully make two or three more putts. I felt I played as good as I did yesterday, just didn't score as good.
