DICKY PRIDE (-8)

Q. Great round today, 2 under for the day and just one off the lead heading into Sunday. Just your thoughts on today.

DICKY PRIDE: I played solid. I made a bad swing on 1 and made bogey and then played really solid after that. I hit a couple shots in close that I hit good putts that didn't go in, so I had to be pretty patient out there. But birdieing the last is nice to be able to get one shot back and head into tomorrow.

Q. You've been doing great at the qualifiers, I think at least two you've qualified for so far?

DICKY PRIDE: I qualified this week. I got a sponsor exemption into Bridgestone and got a sponsor exemption into Sanford International.

Q. So obviously a win tomorrow would get you full eligibility out here. Does that put a little bit more pressure on you?

DICKY PRIDE: Well, I mean, I can't really do much about that, so I'm trying not to -- I'm trying to just take care of what I can do, take care of my golf game. All that other stuff, I can't control what anyone does, so it's not worth spending any time on.

Q. And as far as going into tomorrow, what's your thoughts and your strategy?

DICKY PRIDE: I mean, just sticking to the game plan I've had set up for the week, try to give myself a lot of looks at birdie and just, you know, go from there. That's about all you can do, just execute your game plan and try to make some birdies.
