Q. Tell me about hole 5.

ROBERT KARLSSON: That was great. I didn't come off to the best of starts and I birdied 4. And 5, it's tricky where they put the pin, front right just behind the bunker. The tee was up, so I hit a really, really good 9-iron and from the tee you couldn't see where it ended up, but we heard it hit the pin. Playing four guys today, when we came up there was only three balls on the green, so there it was. It was nice.

Q. How many career hole-in-ones do you have now?

ROBERT KARLSSON: Four on the European Tour and one on the Champions now and a bunch in practice, I think about 10. It was in the practice of the tournaments with the most success.

Q. Do you like -- do you put your ball like, the hole-in-one balls anywhere?

ROBERT KARLSSON: I think it's in my bag somewhere.

Q. And just tell me just in general, it was a good day, right, overall?

ROBERT KARLSSON: Yeah, I played well. Obviously that helped, I birdied 4, eagled 5, birdied 6 and 7, so obviously came off a good round there and 5 under's a good round. It's not easy.
