Summary: **Jim Furyk** defeated **Jerry Kelly** on the first playoff hole to secure his second PGA TOUR Champions title in as many starts. Furyk became the third player to win his first two starts on PGA TOUR Champions, joining **Bruce Fleisher** (1999) and **Arnold Palmer** (1980).

Jim Furyk, 64-73-67—204 (-12)

- With a 3-foot birdie on the first playoff hole, **Jim Furyk** claimed his second PGA TOUR Champions title over **Jerry Kelly** at the PURE Insurance Championship at Pebble Beach Golf Links.
- It was his second win in as many starts on PGA TOUR Champions. In his debut at The Ally Challenge presented by McLaren in August, Furyk became the 19th player to win in his first PGA TOUR Champions event.
- With the victory, Furyk moved up 15 places to No. 8 in Charles Schwab Cup standings.
- Furyk becomes the third player to win his first two starts on PGA TOUR Champions, joining **Bruce Fleisher** (1999) and **Arnold Palmer** (1980).
- It is the second playoff in history at the PURE Insurance Championship following last year's playoff when **Kirk Triplett** defeated **Billy Andrade** on the first extra hole.
- It was the third playoff this season:

- Mitsubishi Electric Championship at Hualalai; Miguel Angel Jimenez def Ernie Els and Fred Couples
- Charles Schwab Series at Bass Pro Shops Big Cedar Lodge: Shane Bertsch def. Bernhard Langer, Kenny Perry and Glen Day
- Furyk finished inside the top 10 a total of five times in 22 starts at the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am.
- The Ponte Vedra Beach, Florida resident is a 17-time winner on the PGA TOUR including the 2003 U.S. Open championship (Olympia Fields Country Club).

Jerry Kelly, 71-68-65—204 (-12)

- Kelly carded eight birdies en route to matching the lowest round of the day with a 7-under par 65, climbing eight places up the leaderboard.
- Last month at the Bridgestone SENIOR PLAYERS Championship, Kelly won his first major championship title by two strokes over **Scott Parel**.
- This week's second-place finish was enough to move him up two places in the Charles Schwab Cup standings to No. 5.
- The Wisconsin native owns a total of seven victories, seven runner-up finishes and 38 finishes in the top 10 in four years on PGA TOUR Champions.
- The start was Kelly's fourth at the PURE Insurance Championship. He finished runner-up to Bernhard Langer in 2017.
- Kelly competed in the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am 18 times with a best finish of T4 in 2000.

Other Notes

- After missing a 3-foot par putt on No. 18 to join Furyk and Kelly in a playoff, Ernie Els finished with a 2-under par 70 for the day. It was the two-time U.S. Open winner's only bogey of the final round.
- **Robert Karlsson** (-8/T6) made a hole-in-one on the 158-yard No. 11 with a 9-iron. It was his first ace in nine starts on PGA TOUR Champions.
- There were three holes-in-one this week: **Ernie Els** (Rd. 1, No.12), **Robin Byrd** (Rd. 1, No. 7) and Karlsson. It's the second time this year (Charles Schwab Cup Series at Big Cedar Lodge) that three or more aces were recorded in a single Champions Tour event. The four holes-in-one at the 2019 Bridgestone SENIOR PLAYERS Championship marked the most in a single week in PGA TOUR Champions history.
- Two-time PGA TOUR winner **Paul Stankowski** finished T45 (+2) in his PGA TOUR Champions debut.
- Winner of last week's Sanford International, **Miguel Angel Jimenez** finished T36 (-1) in his first appearance at the PURE Insurance Championship.
- **Davis Love III** withdrew after the second round due to an injury. **Angel Cabera** withdrew during the final round due to an injury.
- The field included six past champions of the PURE Insurance Championship, here is where they finished:
 - **Kirk Triplett** (2012, 2013, 2019): T31 (-2)
 - **Jeff Sluman** (2011, 2009, 2008): T41 (Even)
 - **Ken Tanigawa** (2018): T36 (-1)
 - **Bernhard Langer** (2017): T8 (-7)
 - **Paul Broadhurst** (2016): T18 (-4)
 - **Esteban Toledo** (2015): T51 (+4)
