Today – Partly cloudy skies this morning will give way to increasing cloud cover into this afternoon. Increasing chances for shower activity will also build across the area this afternoon into the evening ahead of a low pressure system moving into the Ohio Valley. Temperatures in the lower 60s this morning will climb to around 80F this afternoon. Winds this afternoon will be ENE around 5-10 mph. **Sunrise – 6:26am / Sunset – 8:55pm**

Tomorrow – Rain is likely overnight continuing into tomorrow morning as a low pressure system moves across southern Michigan. Gradual clearing of rain is expected into the afternoon with a few lingering showers hanging on into the evening hours. Rainfall amounts of 1-2" are expected with some isolated pockets approaching 3" possible. Heaviest rainfall is expected to occur between midnight and 10am. High temperatures tomorrow will only peak in the mid-70s as showers and cloud cover linger over the area. Northerly winds during the morning will trend NNW during the afternoon with a few gusts to 20 mph.
