










Extended forecast – Waves of showers and thunderstorms may continue into Friday, with the highest chances generally expected during the afternoon/early evening. The leading edge of a drier air mass moves closer to the Kansas City area this weekend. However, if that drier air mass holds off further east, the KC area could remain stuck in an area of increased moisture leading to additional waves of showers/thunderstorms at times through the weekend.
