Today – Mainly dry through the morning, though an isolated shower cannot be ruled out. Widely scattered showers/t-storms become possible after 1pm today, with the highest chances focusing from 5-11pm. Locally heavy downpours are possible with this activity. Winds will be from the southwest up to 16-22 mph at times from 11am-6pm. Highs will be near 85F this afternoon.

Extended forecast – Scattered showers/t-storms remain likely at times Friday and Saturday, mainly during the afternoon/evening hours each day. Southwesterly breezes gust up to 15-20 mph during the day on Friday. Winds on Saturday weaken and turn around out of the north to northeast. On Sunday, drier weather can be expected, but an isolated afternoon shower/t-storm still cannot be ruled out. Winds on Sunday will be the lightest of the tournament, generally from the northeast. Hot and humid conditions continue through the weekend with highs generally holding in the mid to upper 80s.
