Breezy southwest winds, gusting 20-25 mph can be expected through the early afternoon. Extended Forecast – With the frontal boundary stalling north of Savannah Friday night, ample moisture will remain in place. This, along with relatively light winds and mostly clear skies, will promote at least patchy fog development. The daytime hours Saturday likely remain dry, although an isolated shower can't be ruled out along the afternoon sea breeze. Another cold front will approach the area late on Sunday. Any precipitation with this front likely holds off until Sunday night. Strong southerly winds can be expected during the day with gusts of 20-25 mph possible.
