






Extended Forecast – A cold front sinks towards the area Friday morning and likely stalls out just north of Savannah by Friday evening. This front then retreats northward on Saturday. Most of the showers/T-storms with this front likely stay to our north, however isolated activity can't be ruled out each day. A new cold front likely arrives late in the day Sunday and could bring additional shower/T-storm chances. In addition, the warm and humid airmass will allow for sea fog development starting tonight and this could linger through the weekend. This fog may occasionally move onshore, mainly during the overnight and morning hours. Recent trends keep the densest fog offshore.
