**Extended Forecast** – An upper-level disturbance will approach from the southwest on Sunday with increasing clouds and moisture. Clusters of T-storms will likely be found over Mississippi during the day with this activity initially weakening as it spreads into northern Alabama Sunday afternoon. Instability levels will likely be insufficient for lightning with any precipitation that manages to work into the area during the afternoon. The threat for T-storms should increase Sunday evening into the overnight hours. Scattered showers/T-storms will remain possible into Monday morning with a decreasing threat by Monday afternoon.
