Extensive cloud cover likely keep temperatures from climbing out of the upper 70s with south/southwest winds expected much of the day. Most likely rainfall: Less than 0.25". **Sunrise: 6:21am / Sunset: 7:14pm**

**Extended Forecast** – A cold front will slowly move through Ohio Valley tonight with areas of showers/T-storms expected. The most substantial rain should be over by sunrise with just a few lingering showers possible until 9-10am Sunday morning. Dry conditions with diminishing cloud clover is expected Sunday afternoon. Dry and pleasant conditions are expected on Sunday.
