









Extended forecast – A coastal low will develop tonight and slowly track northeastward along the coast on Saturday. Winds will quickly increase tonight and persist through the day tomorrow. Gusts of 30-35 mph appear likely and there is potential for gusts approaching 40 mph Saturday morning. Rainfall amounts remain tricky, and confidence is low. If there is a period of prolonged heavy rain it would most likely occur between 6am-12pm Saturday. Rain chances will slowly diminish Saturday evening with dry conditions likely returning after midnight. Breezy but dry conditions can be expected on Sunday.
