Extended forecast – The main concern will be rainfall amounts Friday night/Saturday, with model guidance now coming into better agreement. An area of low pressure will develop along a stalled front south of Savannah Friday night. The location of the front likely keeps the heaviest precipitation offshore, but the gradient will be very sharp along the coast. Because of this, some fluctuations in rainfall amounts remain possible. Rain chances should come to an end Saturday afternoon with dry and pleasant conditions Sunday. Wind gusts of 20-25 mph will be possible Friday and Saturday with the highest gusts favoring Saturday morning. Somewhat lighter winds are expected on Sunday.
