Extended Forecast – As winds turn more southwesterly tonight, areas fog could move off the Gulf of Mexico. The higher threat for dense fog may remain closer to the coast. A cold front will move through the Florida Peninsula on Friday with a period of showers expected. Lightning could occur on the leading edge of precipitation but instability ahead of this front is meager. Greatest threat for rain is expected between 8am-2pm. Much cooler and drier conditions will spread across the area this weekend. Winds will remain elevated both Saturday and Sunday but should stay below 20 mph.
