**Extended Forecast** – The front moving in today stalls over the area into tonight while an area of low pressure moves along it tomorrow. This will keep rain and thunderstorms in the forecast through at least the first half of Friday before conditions improve. Some of this activity may produce heavy rainfall. Isolated showers and thunderstorms are possible on Saturday, but generally better weather is expected for this weekend. Winds turn from southerly to west on Friday at 10-15 mph, and then become lighter out of the north to northeast for the weekend.
