**Today** – A weak area of low pressure will track east of the Maine coast this morning with a few showers possibly moving onshore between 9am-1pm. Lightning can't be completely ruled out; however, chances are less than 5%. Cloud cover will keep temperatures cooler today and they may struggle to climb out of the 60s this afternoon. Northeast to southeast winds will be in place and generally under 10 mph. Most likely rainfall: Less than 0.05". **Sunrise: 5:00am / Sunset: 8:27pm**

**Extended Forecast** – Increasing low-level moisture could allow for fog to form near the coastline tonight with some of this potentially pushing inland. Some areas of dense fog are possible, but confidence is low. Warm and humid conditions are expected to spread across the region this weekend as an upper-level ridge builds over the NW Atlantic. This feature likely keeps any notable areas of precipitation to our northwest, although a warm front moving through late during the day Saturday could allow for some spotty development near the Maine coast. Onshore flow will be brisk Saturday and Sunday with gusts of 20-25 mph possible both days.
